



Student Dress Code

All Prep to Year Ten students are to be neatly dressed in the correct uniform at all times. This includes extra-curricular situations that require our students to act as representatives of our school. Our Student Dress Code is supported and ratified by our Parents and Citizens Association.



The Allora school community expects students to wear the uniform without alterations or additions. Our uniform, which has been chosen in consultation with students, staff and parents, is worn in the interests of school spirit and identity and allows all students to participate in all school activities in a comfortable and safe manner.

Students are not to wear jewellery apart from plain studs or sleepers in ears - no other body piercing permitted, a watch and a flat signet ring. Make-up and nail polish is not to be worn at school. Long hair is to be tied back neatly with all hair accessories in school colours.

Students are required to wear black shoes with impervious uppers (eg leather). Jogger style shoes with leather uppers and tongue are ideal and can be readily purchased at most shoe retail outlets.

Students are required to wear either the school hat or cap during any outdoor play or activity. The school encourages the wearing of the school hat. The school cap is acceptable but the decision is entirely at the discretion of the parent/guardian.

BOYS AND GIRLS UNIFORM

Shirt: Maroon and navy polo with a white pin stripe. Allora State School Badge on left chest.

Shorts: Plain navy that are no shorter than mid-thigh. (no logos or colours)

Skirt: Girls may wear a plain navy skirt of discreet length (approx knee length), if desired.

Shoes: Black leather (jogger style) to be worn with white socks (no logos or colours).

Hat: Allora State School hat or cap.

Winter: Navy tracksuit pants with maroon pullover, cardigan or jacket. A white skivvy may be worn under the school shirt. A plain navy scarf, gloves and beanie may be worn in winter only. The hat or cap must be worn outside at all times.



Uniforms including hats, caps and school jumpers are available for purchase at the Administration Centre.

NB: The formal uniform is available for School Captains and Vice Captains. The Jersey is only available to year 10 students.
